

For those desiring to become PREP® Master Trainers (someone authorized to train PREP Leaders):

Please be advised that PREP, Inc. is NOT looking for Master Trainers at this time outside of the University Setting. PREP places paramount importance on the integrity of its program and wishes to ensure that trainees receive the same quality of training whether they receive training on the East coast, West coast or foreign lands. Therefore, the Master Trainer position is a **selected** position; not an applied-for position.

Teaching PREP in the University Setting

If you teach in a University Setting and would like to teach PREP to your students, you have several options.

1. You can become trained in PREP and offer PREP as a workshop to your students.
2. You can become trained in PREP and become a Master Teacher to offer PREP Trainings to your students. To do this, you will need to:
 - a. Send PREP, Inc. a current resume or vita.
 - b. Describe your target market, be specific. We do not grant exclusives. We do not grant permission to conduct trainings outside of the core setting or market specified in the agreement with PREP, Inc.
 - c. Attend a **second** full 3-day PREP or CPREP training taught by a Corporate Trainer (Scott Stanley, Natalie Jenkins, and/or Howard Markman.)
 - d. Sign an agreement with PREP Inc. which will stipulate the conditions under which the Trainer is authorized to teach PREP. Our agreement includes parameters to ensure that Master Trainers conduct their trainings as Corporate Trainers do (people sign contracts, format and topics covered, etc.). Trainers are required to mail to PREP evaluations completed by trainees for every training. Trainers are required to maintain high evaluation scores.

4. You can use any of our books as supplemental material in your psychology, marital theory, or similar courses without any further PREP training.
